

Bright colors, no outlines and minimal detail to increase visibility for people with visual impairments. Based on PCS Classic.

Realistic, scenic illustrations of daily activities and community interactions, helpful for people struggling to process symbolic representations.

Illustrations of sign language as symbols, available in ASL (American Sign Language) and SEE (Signing Exact English).
