### Our Business

### Our Commitment

Tobii Dynavox is committed to conducting business ethically and with integrity. We do not tolerate slavery, servitude, forced or compulsory labor, or human trafficking in any part of our operations or supply chains.

### Our Supply Chains

Our supply chains include technology manufacturers, logistics providers, and service partners. We aim to work with suppliers who share our values and uphold human rights standards, and we require our suppliers to agree to and comply with our Supplier Code of Conduct.

### Policies and Due Diligence

- We maintain a **Supplier Code of Conduct** that prohibits forced labor and human trafficking.
- We conduct **risk assessments** and **due diligence** on suppliers, particularly those in high-risk regions.
- We provide **training** to enable relevant staff to recognize and respond to signs of modern slavery.

### Monitoring and Reporting

We encourage employees and stakeholders to report concerns through our **whistleblower channel**. All reports are investigated and addressed appropriately.
